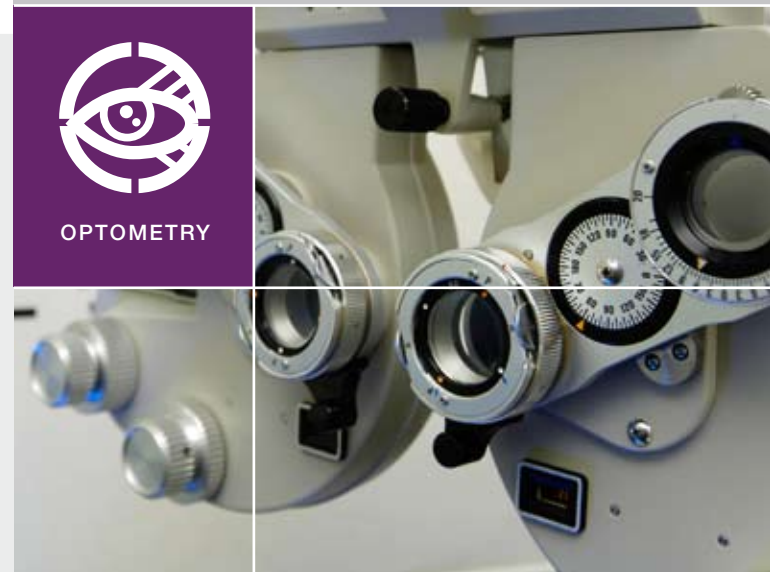
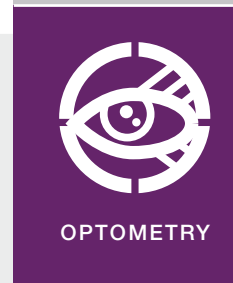
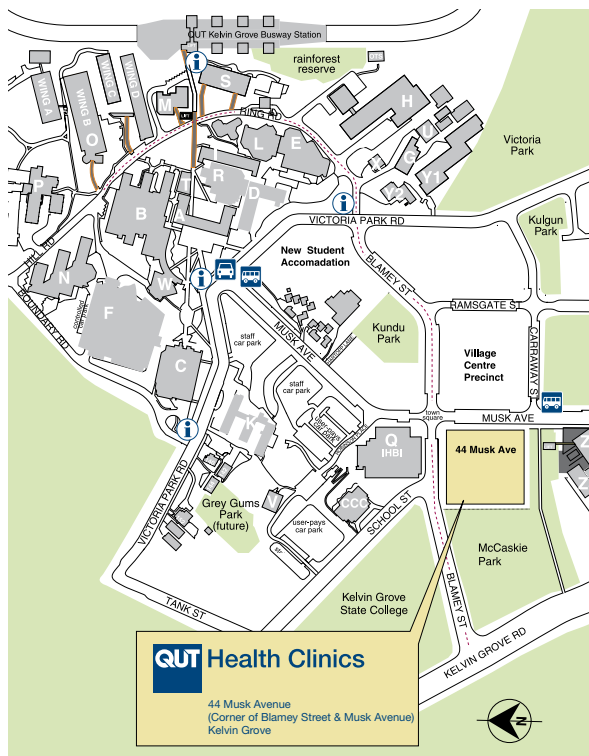

OPTOMETRY

The Optometry Clinic is a community service clinic, open to all members of the public, as well as QUT staff and students. It is a teaching clinic, providing clinical experience to School of Optometry students. Eye examinations are conducted by optometry students under the direct supervision of fully qualified optometrists.

As well as general optometry services, a range of specialist eye care services are available. Some of these are:

VISION REHABILITATION CENTRE (VRC)

A range of vision rehabilitation services to meet the needs of patients (of all ages) with low vision is available on Wednesday and Friday mornings, from 9.00am to 12.00noon. Appointments are necessary. The knowledge, expertise and services of a social worker, occupational therapist and orientation mobility instructor are available.

CONTACT LENS

A comprehensive contact lens service, which includes fitting and dispensing, contact lens care and maintenance, as well as after-care, is available to patients on Monday and Wednesday afternoons.

BINOCULAR VISION AND PAEDIATRIC

Children under the age of 16 are encouraged to attend this clinic, and will be provided with thorough eye care and vision assessment. The Binocular Vision and Paediatric service is open on Tuesday afternoons.

COLOUR VISION ASSESSMENT

Complete colour vision assessment and diagnosis of colour vision abnormalities is provided. A fee may be charged for this service. Appointments are necessary.

OTHER INFORMATION

The Clinic provides a full and comprehensive dispensing service for spectacles, contact lenses and other optical aids at competitive prices.

The Clinic can assist patients who are holders of Pensioner Concession Cards or Health Care Cards, in obtaining free spectacles through the Queensland Hospital Scheme, and also patients who are eligible for optical services through the Department of Veterans Affairs.

TRANSPORT OPTIONS

There are various forms of transport available when travelling to and from the QUT Health Clinics. Here are some of the choices:

The QUT Health Clinics have undercover parking available for clinic patients. Entry to the car park is located in Blamey Street (refer to map overleaf). The car park is entered via a boom gate. Once you enter the car park, please press the call button and the boom gate will raise to allow access. Lift access to all clinics is available from the car park.

Taxi drop-off is located at the Blamey Street side of the building, a short walk to the ground floor entrance in Musk Avenue.
