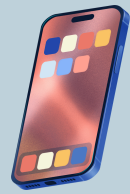




PARTICIPANTS WANTED!



Participate in Research - Overlay for Digital Devices

We are testing a screen overlay which fits on top of mobile phones and eliminates the need for reading spectacles. We want to know how well people see with it, and their impressions of how it works.

What will you be asked to do?

Your participation involves:

1. A 30 minute screening to determine your suitability for the study. This involves an assessment of your spectacle prescription, visual acuity, optical aberrations, focusing ability, and light scatter within the eye.
2. Eligible patients will then be asked to read letters on a mobile phone with and without the overlay device to determine visual acuity at near. This should take no more than 30 minutes and will occur on the same day as the screening tests.

Participants will receive a \$50 gift card for initial screening tests, and an additional \$50 gift card if the second phase of testing is completed.

Who is eligible?

- Aged between 50-65 years
- Good distance vision without the need for spectacles
- Have trouble with close work which is relieved with reading glasses
